The REU program received 106 applications which met our target metric. 31 active offers were made for 33 positions. 21 offers were accepted. 2 more positions are available. Several ECO representatives were going to check to see if they could take another REU student. Please notify Karina if you are interested in extending an offer to a fourth REU student.

For the purposes of keeping everyone informed, the REU program has two blocks. Block 1 will begin on Tuesday, May 30th. We ask that you keep May 31st from 10am-12:30pm Central Time open since this will be the scheduled time for the NHERI REU Orientation which students will be required to attend. Important information will be given to students at this time. Block 2 will

begin on Monday, June 18th and their REU Orientation will be held on June 19th from 1pm-2:30pm Central Time. Please do not schedule any activities during this time.

All students will be travelling to OSU for their research presentations, networking, and tour of the OSU experimental facility. Students will have their flights, meals, and hotel paid for by UTSA (NHERI grant). Please advise REU Block 1 students that they must return home after August 7th.

All students will be required to submit deliverables on time. They will be asked to have timesheets signed by their mentor. They will have weekly self- and program-evaluations. Students will also be asked to submit weekly research paper drafts, a lesson plan geared towards their research, a final research paper to be submitted on DesignSafe, a final presentation and a poster.

Attendance to Research meetings and Career workshops and presentations is required. Please do not schedule activities during these times.

We still need more presenters for at least two of the career workshops. Lehigh has volunteered for two. We would like more EF sites to present on behalf of their university. Please notify Karina of any potential presenters. The career panel on July 23^{rd} will showcase NHERI professionals and their career paths.
