Questions—

- Would you be willing to go to an 8-week REU format in 2023?
- We debated the benefits and possible challenges of moving to an 8-week REU format. While the 8-week format would stretch housing subsidy. Further, if we move to a one block system it would not eliminate conflicts with university housing availability. It would also help us meet the newest NSF pay rate of \$600 per week per student, but all sites would have to have projects ready to launch June 5. We might be able to do this by Including mentors in Meet & Greet (last two weeks of April) to get to know student and identify project by June 5. We all agree that a one block system would be beneficial for Block II students, but the question is still would the 8-week format rushing learning and research such that it would impact the participant's experience.
- OSU has agreed to host NHERI REU Research Symposium on a different date if necessary.
- We received the go ahead at the NCO meeting on Friday, December 16 to submit a supplemental funding request to NSF to increase REU stipend from \$500 to \$600. We would keep the 10-week format if we
