<u>Remote Work Survey Results-</u> Rosie shared the survey during one of the ECO meetings. It helped identify areas where the ECO and each site may support the REU participants. I will email the responses for your REU participants to you, but this is what I found:

We have 6 students that will be in-person, and they were permitted not to take the survey. Only 12 of 22 hybrid and virtual participants took the survey. Sixty-seven percent have Windows the other 33% have MacOS. All but one participant indicated that they had technology that would permit them to meet virtual. One participant indicated they didn't have a microphone. Eighty-three percent said they had strong enough bandwidth to meet virtually and perform necessary online tasks like download assignments, while 17% were unsure. Nine of the twelve students have Slack accounts as well as a quiet place to work all the time. Three students indicated that sometimes they did not have a quiet place to work.

Most students indicated they could complete a full eight-hour day or more without interruptions. Only one student indicated they could only work 4 hours without interruption. Students were allowed to select all the times they would prefer to meet synchronously: 6 selected morning (8-11), 8 midday (12-2), 7 afternoon (3-6), and 2 evening (7-9) Central Time. When asked how often they would like to meet with their research group, 7 selected three times per week, and 5 selected daily. Finally, only one participant shared that they would sometimes need to watch their siblings. They also were quick to share that it would not interfere with their work.

I held three NHERI REU Meet & Greet Meetings May 5-7. One student did indicate he borrowed a student's tablet to complete his participant agreement and did not have WiFi when living off campus; however, he did not complete the virtual survey. The site has been notified, but it may be that students do not wish to share their struggle for a myriad of reasons. I did share with students in the PPT and on Zoom that we knew working remotely could pose challenges and we would be glad to help them work through any situation as well as the option for them to use the subsidy for necessary items.
