4. NHERI REU Summer Program

NHERI REU Summer Program Important Dates

We currently have 6 applications and 93 applications in process for the NHERI REU program. I have contacted the applicants that have completed the email section of the application to offer support and to answer questions. Scott Brandenburg also let us know that he and Karina have worked on how to incorporate Inclusive Excellence into the REU Seminar. There were no changes to the REU hosting capabilities this month, and we continue to move forward with planning a face-to-face option. The next REU Virtual Recruitment Event will be from the AGU Booth on December 17th from 4:00-5:00 pm CST.

Laura Lowes suggested that we might rethink how we conduct REU if we use a remote option this summer. She suggested that the main chunk of the program be run by ECO. Each REU participant would complete a project around a common theme and connect with sites as necessary. She suggested using data from the sites to complete simulation/AI research that can be examined remotely.

NHERI 2021 Summer Institute Options

*The <u>options</u> below provide a <u>draft</u> of what a fully remote or combination hybrid/remote Summer Institute might look like on June 16-17, 2021. We are asking for the ECO Committee and NHERI sites to help evaluate and adjust the schedule options to ensure the NCO, ECO, and each site are able to implement them in a way that benefits everyone involved.

Option A: Fully Remote

In this option, the ECO will purchase the services of PheedLoop or a similar conference hosting platform to allow for an extended schedule with live and on-demand sessions. The platform will allow us to make use of session chat, private chat, private video, roundtable discussions, breakout meetings, live streaming, scheduling meetings, polling, poster sessions, and site booths. 




